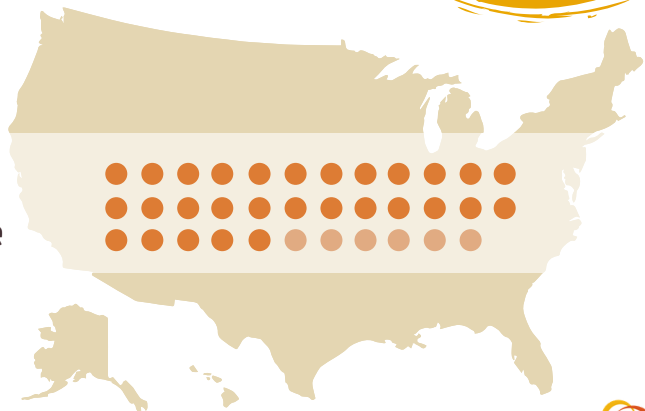
Newborn Screening Conditions by State

Did you know?
Newborn screening began over 50 years ago and continues to evolve today.

Most states screen for

29 out of the **35**

conditions included on the Recommended Uniform Screening Panel.



Medium-chain acyl-CoA dehydrogenase deficiency (MCADD) is a genetic metabolic condition where the body is unable to break down certain fats.

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With an incidence rate of only 1 in 17,000 births, our son was one of the only MCADD babies detected through newborn screening in Colorado that year. In the days and years since his birth, we have been overwhelmed with gratitude for the life-saving information we gained from his newborn screening - **a test we didn't even know our son had until it saved his life.**
